Life Center is a trusted outreach ministry in Timisoara, Romania. Many youth live in poverty, yet are intelligent and have skills, which when developed help them succeed in life. Our Heavenly Father loves and cares for his children and uses Life Center to meet the needs of these youth by helping with living and training costs and moral support.

Besides their professional studies students are Bible and ministry oriented, reaching to the orphaned and other kids living under poverty. They use evangelism, prison outreach, and other ways to spread the gospel and the good news of God's love.

Here's an old picture since the Life Center was dedicated to God's work. The middle tall man is Phil Caldwell. Phil was the former missions of Life Outreach International, Fort Worth, TX who was with us on those early beginnings. The rest are the Life Center staff members of that time. The five kids of Cristian & Alexandra Bugarschi from Ronat, a Timisoara slum district, through the Life Center the five kids recently were dressed in new clothes, toys and given needed food supplies. The kids had a great time receiving all these supplies, as we got their big smiles expressing their inexplicable joy. When asked they said 'yes, how not to rejoice when we were dressed up and so blessed'. But moreover, they were glad to see their good friends again, the Life Center team. Sure, these kids were won to serve Christ forever!

Ecaterina Muresan, was a lonely old Lady widow in the poor Crisan district of Timisoara. She was forced to cook her meals on a very outdated gas cooker, which was very unsafe with flows. Life team recently blessed this lady. We purchased for her a modern new gas stove, and what a blessing it was when she had seen it how nicely and works smoothly.

Besides the poor, our Life youth are regularly involved in evangelism, help on church plants, and prison ministry.

Reaching three prisons in different cities, including Timisoara. While at their church prison ministry, many locked down men and women are coming to receive prayer. And they've asked our team to teach them how to pray like they do hear them praying. They are also asking for Bibles to read and begging them to get their music CD's as our youth are good singers as well. Sure, all the while some are giving their lives to Christ.

Today, the Life Center is an outreach center more than any other church or ministries are doing in Timisoara city. It blesses our heart to see. Life Center is a double blessing as the rescued ones today became themselves rescuers. They have a great integrity with what they get as every dollar we send it designed for it is used accordingly, Moreover, they are emptying their own pockets to do even the more.

Now, let's travel with our ministerial story to eastern Romania at another missions' center of this far region, Urziceni city, led by bishop Gramada and our younger pastor Vasi Bostiog. They are doing extensive evangelism as here many do not know about salvation message, living in complete darkness. On this outreach we're meeting new people, adding them on our needlest people list, needing emergency rescuing, Here we bring to your attention just one family who needed us badly.

Alexandru & Diana Cheche, and their 3 kids, we met them more than 6 months since they were on our regular assistance service, on a food and clothing provision list. Sure, this family was truly rescued from an



approaching early death as they lived in a dire poverty, using just limited survival food. And once our church intervened, we witnessed progress both spiritually and physically. Their lives had been completely changed, not only they ate better and became healthy, but just recently they gave their hearts to Christ and were baptized to serve Jesus here to evermore.

Now, I do present you our outreach project named; "The beautiful feet heralding salvation and peace."

Romans 10:14 "How then shall they call on Him in whom they have not believed? And how shall they believe in Him of whom they have not heard? And how shall they hear without a preacher?"

This summer the church of Urziceni has planned projects, organizing

evangelism outreaches for the poor, the prisoners and to those who are oppressed by the devil.

We have a poor family example who at the end fully received the Lord as you see in these two pictures. The same over there are more waiting to hear the good news that our Lord is alive and is here to help them too as He did for us. As we still believe in the power of deliverance from the evil one, and the salvation of the poor but precious souls for our God.

Our resources are very limited here as we are living as well in a known poorest area of Romania, but as always CCFR was for us a lifeline buoy, we're praying and believing the support from America will continue to come and be multiplied.
